

Where To Stay In The French Alps: The 8 Most Stylish New Ski Hotels To Know

If you haven't booked your ski vacation yet, then you're in for a treat because these eight new ski hotels in the French Alps are upping the style game from Megève to Méribel, and they've just opened their doors right in time for the European ski season kick-off.

Grand Hotel du Soleil d'Or in Megève - for the traditional chalet fan

The oldest hotel in Megève, the [Grand Hotel du Soleil d'Or](#) (literally, the Grand Hotel of the Golden Sun) originally opened in 1901, and has just reopened its doors after a top-to-bottom revamp.

Part of the Millésime Collection, which counts 10 hotels, eight restaurants and two bars, the Soleil d'Or has been restored to its former glory and updated for today's tastes.

Warm countryside style interiors with dashes of earthy hues flow throughout the hotel including in the 28 rooms and suites. Other standout draws at the **Grand Hotel du Soleil d'Or** include a library of beautifully bound books to read by the crackling fire, a natural mineral Gémology spa with a pool looking out onto a pine forest dusted with powdery snow, a Jean-Paul Hévin *chocolaterie* that offers traditional *chocolat chaud*, and a rooftop cocktail bar with panoramic mountain views.

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
